#### 2023 PAVING PROJECT

- KLH is supporting the PennDOT Municipal Services Specialist as needed for the 2023 paving program. This project has been awarded but has been delayed until the Spring of 2024.

#### VETERANS PARK SIGNS & WATER FEATURE

- KLH has spoken with the Fayette County Chamber of Commerce Director about the project. The Borough has \$17,000 allotted for materials and they can be ordered at any time. KLH explored the option of using the funds for an electronic sign in place of the placards. The Director said that this option would be considered, but a new plan and cost estimate would need to be provided. KLH has obtained quotes for the electronic sign from Mon Valley Signs.

#### DGLVR GRANT APPLICATION

- KLH held a meeting with representatives of the Fayette County Conservation District and the Belle Vernon Borough Street Department in November 2023 and January 2024 to discuss the Dirt, Gravel and Low-Volume Road (DGLVR) Grant application. The project discussed was for the area at the end of Sampson Street. The project scope involves installing new drainage inlets and piping, a new retaining wall, and rebuilding the roadway. KLH is in the process of putting together the Grant Application.

#### 119 MAIN STREET

- Bids were solicited on Monday, February 5<sup>th</sup> for the demolition of a collapsing structure located at 119 Main Street. KLH recommends moving forward with the demolition of the structure.

#### GTRP Grant Application – Brewer Field Redevelopment Phase I

- The Pennsylvania Department of Community Development (DCED) is accepting applications for the Greenways, Trails, and Recreation Program (GTRP) through May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024. The program limit is \$250,000 and a 15% match is required.
