MAYORS REPORT- Mayor states our Street Dept. does a great job keeping roads clear during storms, and we have a good cooperation between boroughs helping each other out as needed. He also says Stephen and Ron attended 811 Training by zoom and that Ron is one of the few with a 100% response rate on calls. Lights have been fixed at the park. Mayor wishes to start a Memorial Day Service and have Saint Sebastian Choir perform as well as a Summer Concert Series and has spoke with NBV Mayor so that schedules do not conflict with their events. Mayor states Steven Collinet will be helping with recreation activities, and that the park can be rented out for parties. Denise suggests a Movie Night in the park, and Mayor says the street can be closed for parking. Lastly the Belle Vernon Borough Easter Egg Hunt will be March 28, 2026

STREETS AND SEWERS REPORT – Ed Stasko Sr states that the borough garage is a dump and they will have it cleaned up by Spring. He says Road Crew did a fantastic job with snow removal. He also states that we do not have a Street Sweeper and the wind blows trash all over our streets that needs to be picked up. Ed also says there are too many vehicles parked on Main Street that aren't inspected and need moved. He shows a photo of a car on a sidewalk being repaired. Cliff asks if Police Chief was notified? Ed responds, no but suggests that first they get a ticket, and second time it gets towed. Krisha advises to call police as they can take immediate action.
